

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS DECLINING TO POSTPONE WITHHOLDING CERTAIN SOCIAL SECURITY TAXES FOR EMPLOYEES FOR THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2020 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, under the Payroll Tax Deferral Plan effective September 1, 2020, the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") may opt to postpone the withholding of 6.2% for Social Security from wages of employees making less than \$104,000.00 a year, for the period ending December 31, 2020, and to be paid back during the period of time from January 1, 2021 through April 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, OCTA Board of Directors ("Board") has discussed the Payroll Tax Deferral Plan, and is adopting this resolution to memorialize the Board's decision on whether or not to opt to follow the Payroll Tax Deferral Plan for OCTA employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OCTA BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. - Declination to Follow the Payroll Tax Deferral Plan.

OCTA shall not opt to follow the Payroll Tax Deferral Plan for its employees. Normal withholding of payroll taxes shall be deducted from wages for OCTA employees during the period of the Payroll Tax Deferral Plan, September 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Section 2. - Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective as of September 1, 2020.


