

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS ADOPTING A TITLE VI PLAN FOR THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, the US Department of Transportation ("DOT") distributes federal financial assistance each year for programs and activities conducted by entities, including local transit authorities; and

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") is a recipient of federal financial assistance, and as such is required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as well as related statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, OCTA is required to adopt a Title VI Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of OCTA has reviewed the proposed OCTA Title VI Policy prepared by OCTA staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF OCTA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Directors does hereby approve the Okanogan County Transit Authority Title VI Policy – Title VI Plan for the Federal Transit Administration attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Section 2. This Resolution, and the aforementioned Title VI Policy, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval and passage.
