**Do you need specialized transportation (paratransit) because a disability prevents you from getting to a bus stop? Call 509-557-6177 to receive an eligibility application.**

### What is Paratransit?

Paratransit is a wheelchair-accessible shared ride transportation service for individuals whose disability prevents them from using the regular fixed route buses. This means that a person must be unable, because of a disability, to get to or from the bus stop, get on or off a lift or ramp equipped bus, or successfully travel by bus to or from the destination.

Eligibility is based on limitations to an individual's abilities, not just the presence of a disability. Age or the inability to drive are not qualifying factors in and of themselves. All of TranGO's regular buses are fully accessible and equipped with ramps in order to board passengers who use wheelchairs. An application for service is required. The application includes a section for verification of your disability from a licensed medical or mental health professional. It is necessary to complete an application form if you wish to use the paratransit service. You may obtain an application by calling 509-557-6177 or by writing to:

TranGO provides bike racks on all their buses. The racks hold two single seat, two-wheeled, non-motorized bicycles.

Each bicycle can be secured independently of one another. Whether you are going to work, school or play, you and your bike can ride the bus.

The schedule is organized to show you bus arrival times. Choose your destination (across the top of the schedule) and look down the column to identify the time you want to arrive.

Follow the row (with your desired arrival time) to the left to find your desired boarding location. You may need to move up one row to find the best location.

### Holidays

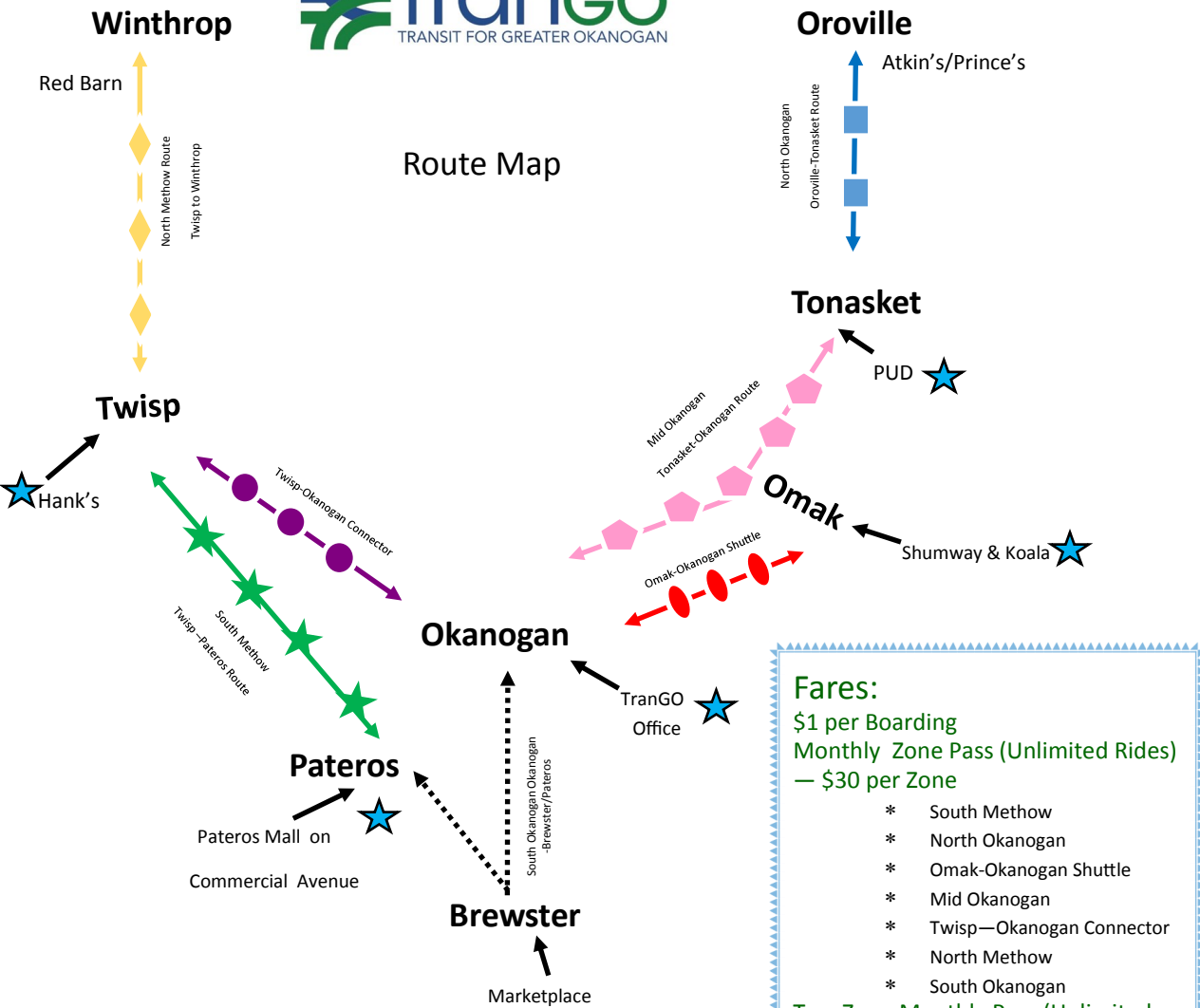
TranGO does not provide service on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day or New Year's Day. On all other Federal Holidays, these routes will run on Schedule.

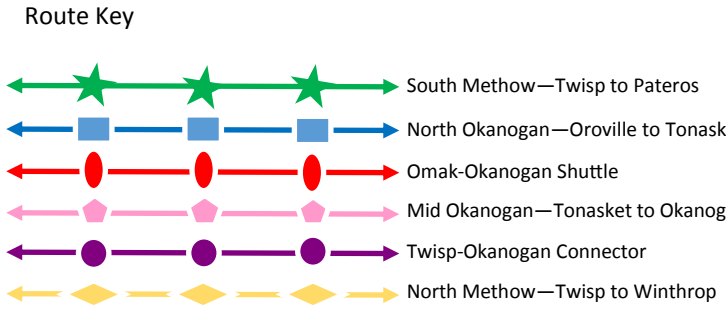
### Route Map
